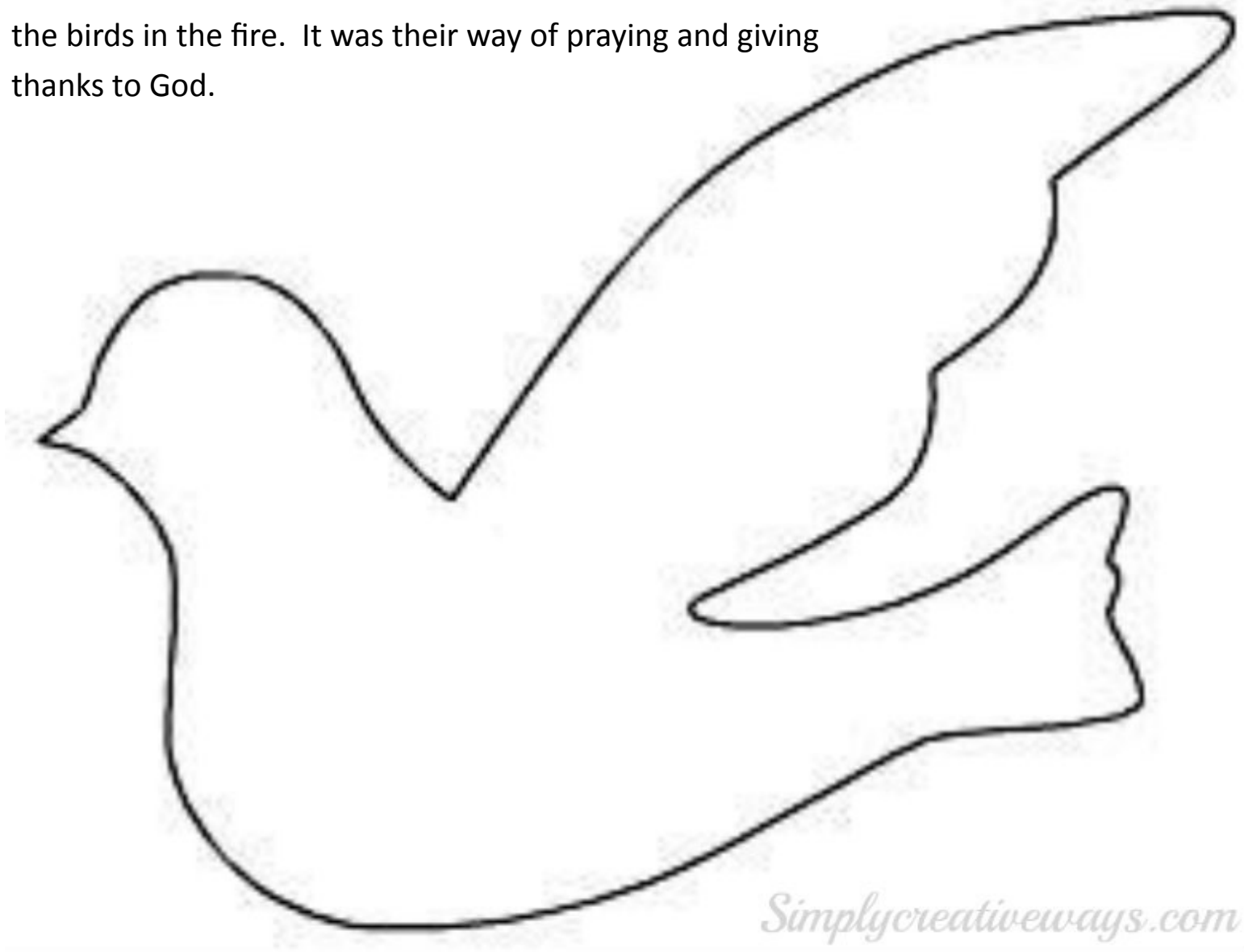


When Jesus and his friends went to the Temple, they had to bring money from home. At the Temple money changers took their money and gave them Temple money.

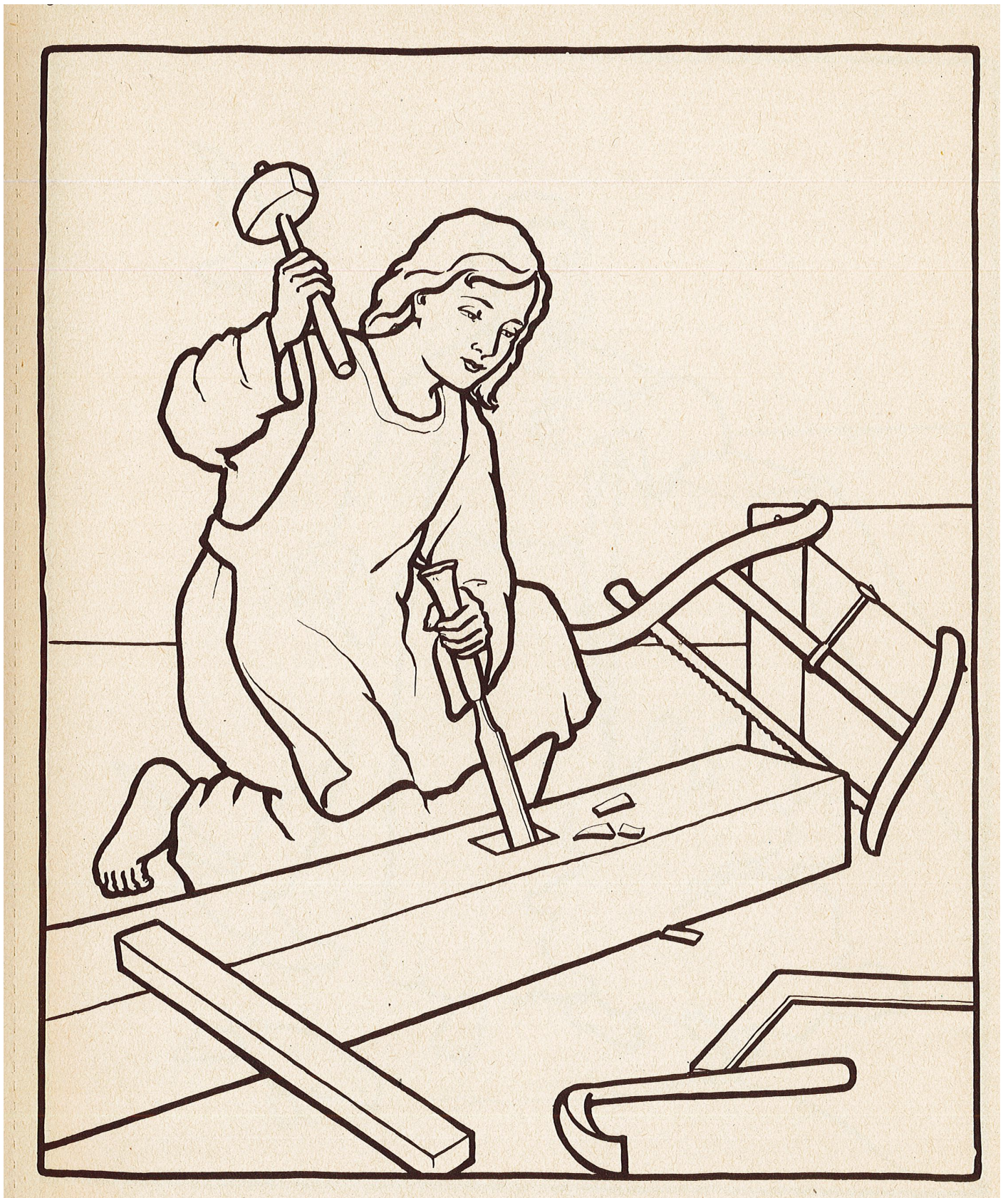




People Jesus knew didn't have lotion. They had perfumed oil.

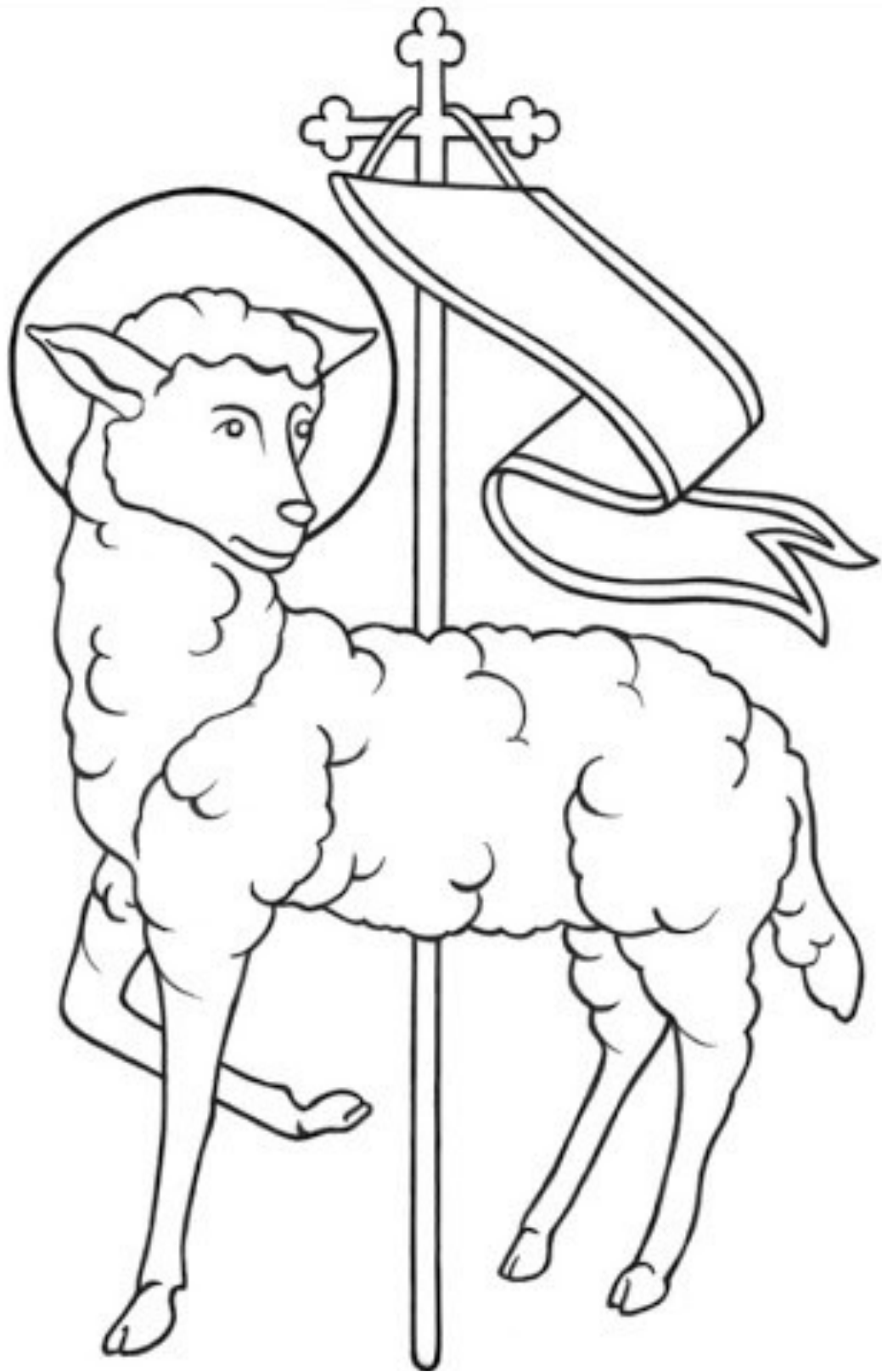
